A man of simple living Dr. Vempati believes that mere dependence on glamour and influence will not help develop the art. Dedication and involvement only can help develop the art.


## Kuchipudi Kalakshetra:

This institution was established by the Kuchipudi Maestro Dr. Vempati Chinna Satyam and some of his close friends in the year 1985. Situated in sprawling area in the midst of environmental friendly area.

Kalakshetra is an ideal institute for the scholars to learn the art in a relatively calm atmosphere. Classes in dance, theories and music are conducted by competent qualified teachers. Guru Dr. Vempati Chinna Satyam has also been visiting the institution at frequent intervals to impart training direct to the students and to review its working.

Dance and allied subjects are taught here Free of charge. For the convenience of students, the Kalakshetra has made arrangements for transportation.

The artistes of Kalakshetra are staging performances based on Guru Dr. Vempati's chareography and is maintaining an orchestra troup of its own.



Neelima was born on 24th January 1979 and she started learning dance at a very young age when she was eight years old. The encouragement provided grandmother who got admitted Kuchipudi Kalakshetra founded and established by the world renowned Kuchipudi maestro Padma Bhushan Dr Vempati Chinna Satyam at Visakhapatnam.



#### Free Rangapravesam Scheme:

It is the legitimate ambition of every artiste to expose public what he / she has learnt. But many of those who have attained proficiency in the art were not able to exhibit their talents to public, because of lack of infrastructure. Dr. Vempati Chinna Satyam, Founder of Kuchipudi Art Academy, Chennai Kuchipudi Kalakshetra, and\* Visakhapatnam who himself had experienced such difficulties in his early age, has therefore instituted a scheme for free Rangapravesam of such talented students in Kuchipudi art. Under this scheme, the artiste selected for Rangapravesam will be provided with all facilities such as stage, orchestra and publicity for staging one public performance, the entire expenditure therefor is, met by this Kalakshetra. A certificate awarding 'Natya Visaradha' diploma is issued by Guru Dr. Vempati Chinna Satyam to the artiste under the seal of the Kalakshetra, together with a memento depicting the name of the institution.

This is the Third such Ranga-pravesam under the above scheme.
